

MYRICK-BETTIS CASE

Beaumont-Orange Legislative Contest Will Be Heard in Houston Tomorrow.

The contest for the right of recognition as the democratic nominee for the legislature between Hon. W. A. Myrick of Beaumont and Colonel W. D. Bettis of Orange will be heard in this city tomorrow.

It will be recalled that both gentlemen claim to have been legally nominated for the place and by agreement they consented to abide such decision as might be reached by a subcommittee of five, to be named for the purpose of investigation by Chairman Frank Andrews of the State democratic executive committee.

That official thereupon designated Messrs. Jake P. Wolters of La Grange, John M. Loggins of Ennis, E. B. Seay of Madisonville, A. E. Masterson of Brazoria and R. J. Alexander of Caldwell to hear the contest, leaving the selection of time and place for such to those most concerned.
