

QUIGLY AT HOUSTON,

Man Held on Suspicion of Burglary Removed by Vann.

Madisonville, Texas, Feb. 7.—Deputy United States Marshal Vann came up from Houston today and left immediately for Houston with the man Quigly, who was arrested at Bedias last week and brought here by Postoffice Inspector Rhodes and Captain E. B. Seay on suspicion of being connected with the Rogers Prairie safe blowing. Inspector Rhodes asked Sheriff Payne to hold this man until he could return to Houston and make an investigation, as he thought probably he was connected with the gang that robbed the LaPorte postoffice, and on describing this man to the men in the Houston jail charged with the LaPorte affair one of them said: "You have got Dillon at Madisonville." While waiting for the train Marshal Vann's prisoner talked freely all the while, asserting his innocence. In fact, the man, from his general appearance and from the callous condition of his hands, would appear to be a laborer.



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
