Action Expected In Kurten School Project Shortly

Prospects for early action on the proposed new Kurten school building are good, according to J. B. Atkinson, who has returned from a conference with PWA authorities at Fort Worth.

Washington headquarters approved a loan and grant for considerably more money than Kurten desired and Mr. Atkinson arranged to have the application revised to call for a grant only, to amount to about \$8,000, as the Kurten trustees will sell the \$10,000 in bonds, recently voted, in the local market. This will give about \$18,000 for construction purposes, the amount originally considered.

An application made by North Zulch for school purposes, covering a combined loan and grant of \$17,000, has been filed but no action has been reported. If approved this would cover a grant of 55 per cent and a loan of 45 per cent.

The firm of J. B. Atkinson and W. Olin Sanders is the architect for the Kurten trustees and also are acting for the North Zulch board.
