

A BILL

to be entitled

AN ACT creating the Willow Hole Independent School District in Madison County, Texas; defining its metes and bounds, providing a board of trustees therefore, vesting it with the ~~rights and duties of districts incorporated for school purposes~~ only under the General Laws, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Willow Hole Independent School District is hereby created in Madison County, containing within its limits the following described territory, to-wit:

Field notes of Willow Hole School District situated in Madison County, Texas, and consisting of lands lying in the following surveys: - Peter Fullenwider, T. R. Marston, L. M. H. Washington, Alfred Gee, Patrick O Roark, U. C. Palmer, Jno. Vance, Thos. Davis, Andrew Montgomery, Jno. Vaughan, James Christian, Jno. Payne, and William Townsend, and beginning at the N. E. Corner of the Jno. McGuire survey on the West line of the James Christian survey.

Thence S 9 W at 621 vrs pass the Southwest corner of Jas. Christian and the N W corner of the Jno. Vaughan surveys, at 1133 vrs pass S E corner of Jno. McGuire and the Butts surveys, 2256 vrs to corner on the N line of the Jno. Payne league.

Thence with the Bryan and Madisonville road as follows: S 81 W 326 vrs; S 9 W 803 vrs; S 53 W 462 vrs; S 45 W 587 vrs to the corner on the west line of Frank Moore's tract.

Thence S 9 W 1476 vrs to corner in the Jno. Payne League.

Thence N 83 30 E at 2125 vrs pass H & T C R R, at 2180 vrs pass T & B V R R, at 3528 vrs pass East line of Jno. Payne and West line of Wm. Townsend Leagues, 7096 vrs to corner in said Townsend league.

Thence N 9 E ¹⁷⁵³ vrs to corner on the N line of said Townsend league and the south line of the Thos Davis survey.

Thence S 81 E 384 vrs to the S E cor. of said Davis survey.

Thence N 8 45 E at 1964 vrs pass N E cor. of said Davis sur-

vey, 3481 vrs to rock in Bryan and Madisonville road on the East line of W. C. Palmer survey.

Thence with said road as follows: S 81 E 517 vrs; N $23\frac{1}{2}$ E 569 vrs; N 26 E 495 vrs; N 17 E 499 vrs; N 39 E 705 vrs; N 51 E 393 vrs; N 39 E 267 vrs to stake on W bank of Kickapoo Creek.

Thence up said creek and Mustang Creek as follows: N $51\frac{1}{2}$ W 95 vrs; N 35 W 162 vrs; N 51 W 3068 vrs; N 80 W 1241 vrs; N 63 W 1462 vrs to stake in the bank of Mustang Creek on the West line of the Alfred Gee League, from which a Pin Oak 16 in mkd X vrs N $4\frac{1}{2}$ W $3\frac{4}{10}$ vrs.

Thence S $\frac{1}{2}$ W with the West line of the said Gee and the East line of the Peter Fullenwider Leagues 3175 vrs to corner.

Thence N 81 W at 2810 vrs pass T & B V R R, at 3078 vrs cor. on South line of North Zulch School District in the Fullenwider league.

Thence S 8 36 W at 1093 vrs pass S line of said Fullenwider league into the T. R. Marston survey 3086 vrs to corner on the Harris Taproad.

Thence with said road as follows; S 50 E 562 vrs; S 81 E 231 vrs to place of beginning, containing 18 sq. miles of land.

Section 2. The said Willow Hale Independent School District is hereby vested with all the powers and duties of an independent school district organized under the General Laws of this State.

Section 3. The control and management of the schools of the said Willow Hale Independent School District is hereby vested in a board of seven trustees, to be elected in accordance with Section 164 of Chapter 124 of the Acts of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature.

Section 4. The deplorable condition of the public free schools within the territory herein described bein now without adequate school buildings and wholly insufficient equipments, and without funds to provide for same, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days be suspended, and that this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

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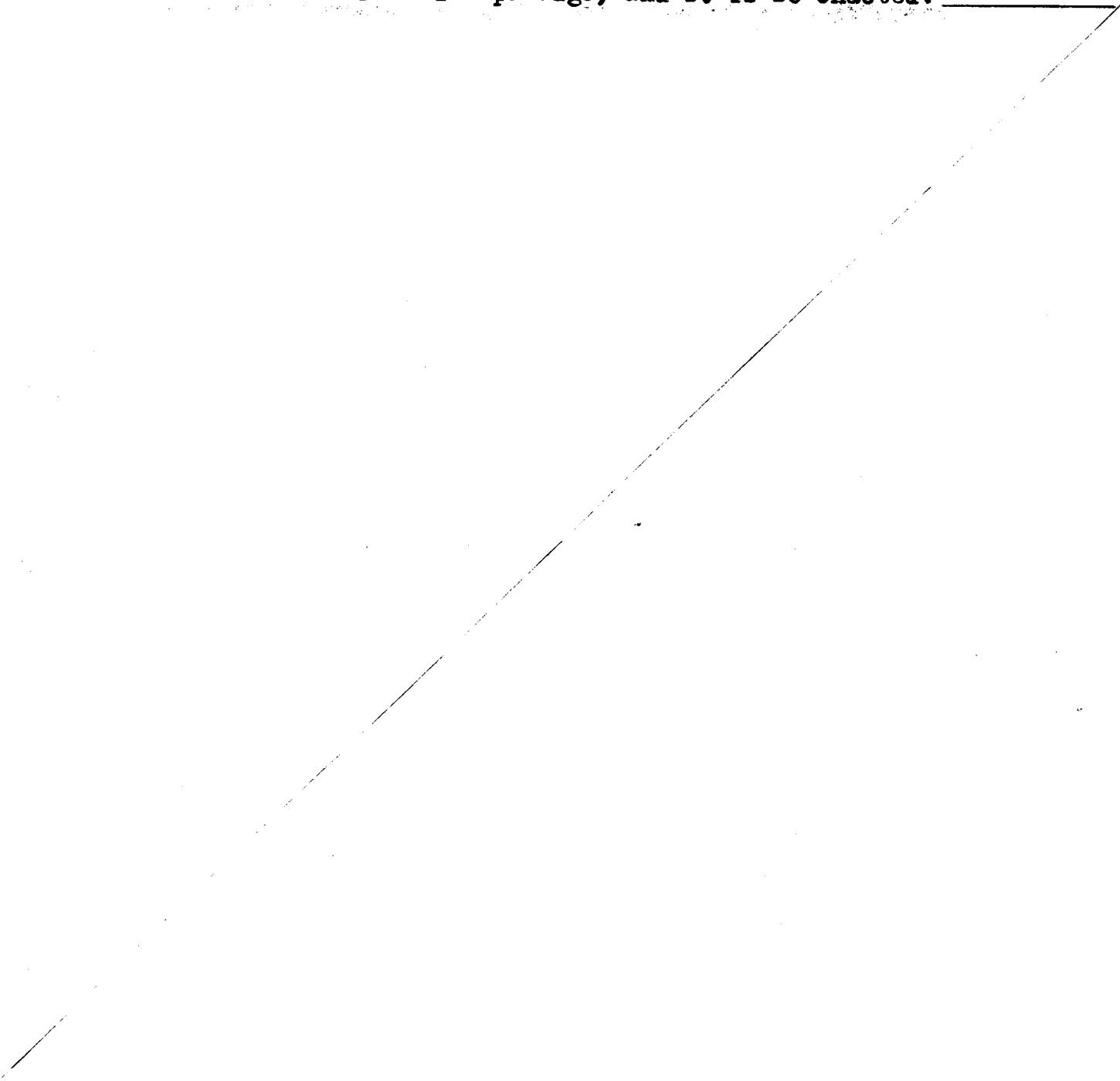
