A BILL

to be entitled

AN ACT creating the Chappell Hill Independent School District in Madison County, Texas, defining the metes and bounds, providing for a Board of Trustees therefor, vesting it with the rights and duties of Districts incorporated for school purposes only, under the General Laws and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Chappell Hill Independent School District is hereby created in Madison County, Texas, containing within its limits the following described territory, to-wit:

Beginning at the S. E. Corner of Mecca School District on South Line of Wm. J. C. Hill Survey; thence with east line of said Mecca School District as follows, N. 9 E. 1082 vrs., S. 81 E. 239 vrs., N. 9 E. 1067 vrs., S. 81 E. 776 vrs., N. 9 E. 556 vrs., S. 80 1/2 E. 403 vrs. N. 10 E. 2019 vrs to N. E. Corner of said Mecca School District on North Line of said Hill Survey, and on South Line of Ten Mile School District; thence with said ten mile School District line as follows: S. 81 E. 828 vrs. to N. E. Corner of said Hill Survey, N. 9 ^{E.} 416 vrs. to N. W. Corner of Geo. L. Ramsdale Survey, S. 81 E. at 355 vrs. pass S. E. Corner of said ten mile District at 1344 vrs., the N. E. Corner of said Ramsdale Survey; thence S. 9 W. with Ramsdale East Line and J. W. Andrews Survey West Line 430 vrs. corner on bank of Brushey Creek; thence down said creek as follows: S. 52 3/4 E. 328 vrs., S. 82 1/2 E. 131 vrs. to stake on West Line of High Prairie School District 66 vrs. from N.W. Corner of same; thence with High Prairie District Line as follows: S. 25 1/4 W. 281 vrs., S. 8 1/2 W. 420 vrs., S. 81 1/2 E. with North Line of D. Ariola Survey 18 vrs., S. 8 3/4 W. 934 1/2 vrs., N. 81 1/2 ^{N. 67 1/2} vrs. S. 9 1/2 W. 1173 vrs., N. 82 1/4 W. 440 vrs., S. 1 1/2 W. 560 vrs., S. 81 1/2 E. 576 vrs., S. 9 W. 1699 vrs. to stake on S. Line of said Ariola Survey, N. 81 3/4

w. 1078 vrs. to S. W. Corner of said Ariola Survey, same being N. W. Corner of High Prairie District on East Line of Hollis School District; thence with said Hollis District Line as follows, N. 9 E. 663 vrs. to S. E. Cor. of said Hill Survey, N. 81 W. 2299 vrs. to place of beginning, containing three and 79/100 square miles of land, the same containing 320 acres of the Geo. L. Ramsdale Survey, 1260 acres of the Wm. J. C. Hill Survey, 803 acres of D. Ariola Survey and 480 acres of J. W. Andrews Survey.

SECTION 2. The said Chappell Hill Independent School District is hereby vested with all the powers and duties of an independent School District organized under the general laws of this State.

SECTION 3. The control and management of the schools in the Chappell Hill Independent School District is hereby vested in a board of seven trustees, to be elected in accordance with Section 164 of Chapter 124 of the Acts of the Twenty-ninth Legislature.

SECTION 4. The deplorable condition of the public free schools within the territory herein described, being now without adequate school buildings and wholly inadequately equipped and without funds to provide the same creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the Constitutional Rule requiring bills to be read on three several days be suspended, and that this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Chappell Hill Independent School District is hereby created in Madison county, Texas, containing within its limits the following described territory, to-wit:

S 81 E 239 vrs., N 9 E 1067 vrs., S 81 E 776 vrs., N 9 E 556 vrs., S 80-1/2 E 403 vrs. N 10 E 2019 vrs. to N E corner of said Mecca School District on north line of said Hill Survey, and on south line of Ten Mile School District; thence with said ten mile school district line as follows: S 81 E 828 vrs. to N E corner of said Hill Survey, N 9 E 416 vrs. to N W corner of Geo. L. Ramsdale Survey, S 81 E at 355 vrs. pass S E corner of said ten mile district at 1344 vrs., the N E corner of said Ramsdale Survey; thence S 9 W with Ramsdale east line and J. W. Andrews survey west line 430 vrs. corner on bank of Brushy Creek; thence down said creek as follows: S 52-3/4 E 328 vrs., S 82-1/2 E. 131 vrs. to stake on West line of High Prairie School District 66 vrs. from N W corner of same; thence with High Prairie District line as follows: S 25-1/4 W 281 vrs., S 8-1/2 W 420 vrs., S 81-1/2 E with north line of D. The deplorable condition of the public free schools within the territory herein described, being now without adequate school buildings and wholly inadequately equipped and without funds to provide the same creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days be suspended, and that this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
